100% Smoke-free Restaurants	YES	NO <u>Smoking allowed</u> in parts of restaurants that sell alcoholic beverages and are separated by partitions/ventilation
100% Smoke-free Bars	YES	NO <u>Smoking allowed</u> in establishments where the primary purpose is the sale, service and consumption of alcohol
100% Smoke-free Bowling Alleys and Pool Halls	YES	NO <u>Smoking allowed</u> in parts of establishments that sell alcoholic beverages and are separated by partitions/ventilation
Designated Enforcement Agency	YES Arizona Department of Health Services	NO
Fair Penalties for Violations of the Law	YES ·Civil penalty of \$100-500 for a violation by a business ·Petty offense of \$50-300 for a violation by an individual	NO · <u>No penalties for a business</u> that allows smoking where it is prohibited ·A bar owner who permits minors to enter a bar or fails to post signs is guilty of a class 3 misdemeanor ·Petty offense of \$50-300 for a violation by An individual
Weakens existing smoke-free ordinances in local jurisdictions	NO	YES <u>Rolls back</u> all city/town/county laws relating to smoking in bars and retail tobacco stores
Prohibits future smoke-free ordinances in local jurisdictions	NO	YES <u>Preempts</u> all city/town/county laws relating to smoking in bars and retail tobacco stores


